## Nemont Distance Learning Assistance

As your local Broadband provider, Nemont would like to do its part to help support the schools and students it serves by providing internet access and the necessary tools to support distance learning initiatives.

### Nemont's Contribution

- Assist in providing public WiFi Access Points in several communities in our service areas for students to gain access to on-line learning resources.
- In partnership with the schools, Nemont will provide an internet connection based upon identified needs to the homes of students. This service will be provided at a charge of \$25 per month per household and will be billed to the school for the remainder of the school year.
- Provide up to a 30Mbps connection where possible.
- Waive all installation and equipment fees for new services. If it's a reconnect and the equipment is no longer available, there will be a charge.
- Provide public WiFi Access Points in communities where needed and assist schools that are deploying their own WiFi Access Points when necessary.

### School's Responsibility

- Internet will be charged to the schools at \$25 per month per household for the remainder of the school year.
- This special pricing is for students/Teachers who do not currently have Nemont internet.
- If a student/Teacher currently has internet with Nemont they cannot disconnect and reconnect under the school to get this special offer.
- Once they are connected they will be connected to the end of the school year. If they disconnect we will not reconnect them as our resources are very limited at this time.
- At the end of this program the school will be responsible for collecting the equipment which will remain the property of the school. If the school did not collect the equipment to reuse in the fall of 2020 there will be a charge of \$150 to replace the previously donated equipment.

Nemont would like to thank the schools and Superintendents for working very hard to gather the information needed to help provide students and teachers these necessary resources.
