Dear Poplar High School parents/guardians/students/community:

This letter is to inform you during this unprecedented time, in not only Montana, but the Nations educational history that the Emergency Operations Team has been meeting and putting together a reopening plan for Poplar High School, which was approved by the School Board. We want to ensure that your child's education and safety are our #1 priority during this pandemic.

We will be operating under a Maroon and Gold days schedule. If your student is a Maroon student, they will only be face to face with their teachers on Mondays and Wednesdays. Gold students will be face to face with their teachers on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Fridays are set to be an intervention outreach day with tutoring options that will be determined by appointment only by the classroom teacher. We will be training all our staff and plan on using Google Classroom to reach your students during their off days. The Poplar High School is excited to announce that every student will be set up 1-1 with their very own Chromebook!

We also have a third option that we are calling our "Remote" students. This option is for those who wish to be in remote status only with no face to face interaction with the teacher. You will still be a student of the district and be able to participate in extracurricular activities if you choose to do so. We will be utilizing our Acellus program to reach our remote students. If you plan on placing your student into remote status PLEASE CALL VONDA AT THE HIGH SCHOOL OFFICE AT 406-768-6833 or email myself or Vonda.bighorn@poplarschools.com, by August 21st so that we can get our schedule finalized by the first day of school. If you do not reach out to us, we will assume your child is going to participate in the Maroon and Gold days. If you decide on remote status there is paperwork that needs to be filled out and signed by student and parent/guardian.

Below you will see where the break down is for Maroon and Gold students as well as how the first few days of school will operate for the High School (this is tentative).

Maroon Day Students will be Monday and Wednesday
Gold Day Students will be Tuesday and Thursday
Fridays will be Individualized Education Assistance by appointment only
Remote Day Students will be Remote Only via Acellus
